Contingency Plan

- In 2019, the Directorate of Environment and Climate Change (DOECC) at the Office of the Prime Minister, started exploring the possibility of establishing Contingency Centre for oil spill.
- PERSGA supported the Directorate by sending two experts to carry out an assessment.



Contingency Centres:

- The Directorate discussed and agreed with the experts that the head centre will be in Mogadishu while sub-centres will be establishing in Kismayo, Berbera and Bosasso.
- Establishment of the Contingency Centre is the 2022 workplan of the Directorate.



Additional Support

- There is possible support that may be received from Nairobi Convention.
- PERSGA is also in discussion related to sharing protocols and experts on oil spill.
- DOECC is in preparation of translating the Regional Protocol concerning Technical Cooperation for Borrowing and Transfer of Experts, Technicians, Equipment and Materials in Cases of Emergency.
